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## Presbyterian Youth Triennium Indianapolis, IN July 24-27, 2022

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**Join us for Triennium, the National Youth Conference for the PC(USA) and Cumberland Presbyterians!**  
Every three years, 5,000 youth from across the country converge for Presbyterian Youth Triennium! This year we gather at the Indiana Convention Center in Indianapolis, IN, to worship together and grow in our faith through the theme: "When Did We See You?" We'll ask important Matthew 25 questions, exploring how we as young people can do our part in dismantling structural racism, eradicating systemic poverty, and building congregational vitality.

We will SEE OTHERS | We will SEE ALL  
We will understand what it means to truly SEE!

There is nothing like worshiping, playing games, having "lens lab" discussions, praying, and trading pins with Christians your age from across this country, and around the world, too! Triennium only comes every three years, and it's finally your turn! Don't miss being seen at Triennium 2022!



**Who can go?** Any current 8th-12th grader! Churches can sponsor a group of students, or students can register on their own. We also need 1 adult chaperone for every 10 students and an adult or two who are willing to attend the conference as drivers! Adult chaperones and drivers must be 22 or older and pass a background check.



**When is it?** The Triennium trip is July 24-27, 2022. We'll leave from Little Rock very early on Sunday, July 24, and drive all the way to Indianapolis. An overnight space will be provided for those attending both Montreat and Triennium and those who need to arrive in Little Rock on Saturday evening. Triennium runs from Sunday evening, July 24, through Wednesday morning, July 27. We will arrive back in Little Rock on the evening of July 27. We will travel in rented vehicles driven by volunteers from the Presbytery of Arkansas.



**Where is it?** Indiana Convention Center in Indianapolis, IN. Yes, this is a change from previous years. Instead of staying in various dorms around Purdue University, we will be staying and eating at hotels within a few blocks from the convention center. No more walking 10 miles a day, and we ALL get air conditioning!!!

**How much does it cost?** The trip will cost at *most* \$1,000. This includes conference costs, food and housing, transportation, and even an AR Presby T-shirt. Meals while traveling (1 lunch and 2 dinners) will be out-of-pocket.

**How do I register?** Register and pay your deposit via the buttons on:

<https://www.presbyark.org/ministries/youth-a-team/> Registration is due on January 15, 2022, and a \$100 non-refundable deposit is required to secure your spot. If you register *and* you submit your deposit by December 20, you will receive \$50 off your final trip cost. Your trip cost must be paid in full by June 1, 2022.

**Triennium Young Adult Opportunity!** Triennium has a work crew option for young adults (19-23 years old). The work crew helps behind the scenes to put on the conference for the youth of our nation. Work Crew pays the adult conference price (\$535) but Triennium provides food and housing. Work Crew can travel on their own, or ride with the Presbytery of Arkansas (estimated travel cost: \$400 a person). The Presbytery of Arkansas has some scholarship money available to help Young Adults participate in leadership opportunities like this. ## ***Additional Information About Summer Trips with the Presbytery of Arkansas***

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***Who is sponsoring these trips?*** The Youth A-Team of the Presbytery of Arkansas sponsors all summer trips. The Presbytery of Arkansas will handle all registration details, arrange transportation, and provide adult chaperons. The Presbytery also uses designated budgets to help supplement the cost of these trips.

***What is the Youth A-Team?*** The Youth A-Team (Youth Advisory Team or YAT) is made up of youth (10th-12th graders), college-aged students, and adults who care about young people and about youth ministry. The Youth A-Team plans events and trips for the Presbytery of Arkansas. They accept new members every year; applications open in late spring for the following school year.

***What happens after I register?*** You should receive an automatic reply from google forms after you register to confirm that your application has been received. Next, Brianne will send out confirmation emails after December 20 and January 15 to confirm that we have received your deposit and that your stop is secure. As the trip approaches, participants will receive more information about specific details for your trip!

*If at any point, you do not receive the email communication that you are expecting, please reach out to Brianne immediately!*
